ICAS Maths and English Success

During term 3 some students in years 2 to 10 competed in the International Competition and Assessments for Schools in Mathematics and English. This competition is run in the same week all over the country and students answer some multiple choice and short answer questions. In Mathematics, 9 students received a Merit, 10 students received a Credit and Taleigha Atkinson and Angus Petherick received a Distinction. In English, 1 student received a Merit and 5 students received a Credit and Scarlett Bates and Grace Dubsky received a Distinction. Congratulations to all who participated.

2023 Newsletter

Earlier this year we canvassed the school community about receiving an emailed newsletter as opposed to the current hardcopy version.

From term 1 2023, the newsletter will be emailed to all families, as well as a newsletter link provided on Class Dojo and Facebook to the school's website.

In addition, the newsletter will continue to be uploaded to Daymap.

Limited hardcopies will be available at the Front Office. Should your child feature in a newsletter and you wish to have a hardcopy as a keepsake, this will be printed and provided as a one-off upon request.

The newsletter is written and produced on site, with printing costs dramatically rising in the past 12 months.

A big benefit of receiving a digital version is knowing the newsletter will no longer be lost at the bottom of the school bag.

Middle School Transition

On Thursday 1st December, we welcomed 120 transition students into our Middle School. Approximately 70 of those students are our current Year 6 cohort and the other 50 students have come from surrounding schools. Students were divided into small groups and were treated to a tour around the school by our current Middle School students. They covered all corners of the 7-12 side of the school. During recess and lunch, students stayed on the 7-12 side of the school and connected with students who they have previously been at school with. After lunch students completed a 'Race Around the School' to find answers to 10 questions about Kadina Memorial. The day finished with students gathering to ask final questions and to be given a rundown on the next full day of transition.

Tuesday 6th December saw students returned to complete a full day as a Middle School student. Students were divided into 4 care groups and a small group connected in with our hub group. Lesson 1 was spent in a Pastoral Care lesson with their care group teacher that they had been allocated for the day. This year for the first time we had Year 9 and 10 students join the classes as mentors. They supported students by ensuring they were able to find where they were going, answered questions and assisted them with the activities that they were involved in. Classes participated in English/Maths, PE, Science, Home Ec and The Arts (either Music, Drama or Visual Art). By the end of the day there was a good level of conversation amongst the students. We also discussed finding their care group room on the first day of Term 2023 – and also reminded students that photos occur in week 1.

While we have completed the transition program for this year – we know students are on a steep learning curve and have lots more to learn about the Middle School as we do about them. We look forward to working with students and families in 2023.
