

Kadina Memorial Outstanding SACE results 2022

Kadina Memorial School achieved an outstanding 68 A-minus and above grades in this year's SACE results, with one Merit.

Congratulations to Year 12 Dux – Southwood Medalist Alexa Mill who achieved an impressive raw Australian Tertiary Admission Ranking of 95.6, with Connor Guerrero as Runner Up Dux, achieving 92.7, closely followed by Mackenzee McCauley, with an ATAR of 90.95.

In total there were eight A+ results, congratulations to:

Of the 74 SACE completers, there were an additional eight students who achieved an ATAR in the mid to high 80's, and 66.7% of grades were in the A and B grade band.

The results show the many pathway choices open to school leavers, with half seeking an ATAR to study at tertiary level, whilst the majority of those who did not opt for an ATAR have secured traineeships, apprenticeships, and employment opportunities.

Overall, this is an outstanding result, acknowledging the solid work undertaken by students, supported by Teachers, School Service Officers and their families throughout the year.

Kadina Memorial School has a vibrant and exciting Arts Department which includes Creative Arts (Mrs Jacq Barry, Mr Luke Atkinson), Drama (Mr Andre Starr), Visual Art (Ms Karen George), Music (Mr Sandy Hahn), R-6 Arts (Mr Ben Graefe) and our continuing Instrumental Music teachers (Kerrin Williams, Ben Parkin and Jim Glaister).

At Kadina Memorial School we offer all Reception to Year 6 students a yearlong Performing Arts program that includes learning skills from Drama, Music and Dance. Student lockers – combination locks

A reminder all Year 8 students require a combination lock for their locker in 2023.

Combination locks are available for Year 8-12 student lockers at a cost of \$22.00 incl GST from the School Finance Office. Payment may be made at the Finance Office window or through Qkr or online. These locks have a 3-digit access code and students are encouraged to come to the Finance Office so the code chosen can be recorded. You may wish to purchase a lock from a retailer of your choice, however, if for any reason access is needed to a student's locker, the lock may need to be removed, if the code is unknown.

Year 7, 8 and 10 Immunisation Consent Forms

School Immunisation Program consent forms accompany this week's newsletter for years 7, 8 and 10. Students in **Year 7 and 8** are offered free vaccines under the National Immunisation Program to protect them from diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough, and human papillomavirus (HPV).

All students in **Year 10** will be offered free vaccines for both meningococcal B and meningococcal ACWY.

Both meningococcal B and meningococcal ACWY vaccines are recommended for adolescents even if they have received a previous dose of meningococcal C vaccine or meningococcal ACWY vaccine.

Please read the consent form and return signed consent forms to school by week 3, **Thursday 16**th **February**.

Year 7 Immunisations are scheduled for week 5, Wednesday 1st March; year 8 Immunisations planned for Thursday 2nd March; year 10's will be in term 2, week 2 Tuesday 9th May.
